SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SCHOLARS...

Is a nonprofit organization that awards scholarships to top performing high school seniors who reside in Anne Arundel County (AAC). Since its founding in 1984, the organization has awarded over \$4,000,000 to county students.



ELIGIBILITY

- Scholarships are awarded to graduating high school seniors who are AAC residents attending public and private schools in AAC, and AAC residents who are home-schooled.
- An applicant must have a minimum weighted GPA, either 3.75 or 3.5, which differs by scholarship.
- Scholarships are awarded without regard to financial need, race, gender, age, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, or familial status.

- Students may apply to two scholarship categories but can be awarded at most one scholarship.



TIMELINE 2024 - 2025

- **October 15:** Applications available
- **February 4:** Student portion deadline
- **February 11:** Transcript and letters of recommendation deadline
- **April 2:** Decisions announced
- **April 30:** Awards ceremony
